Title FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS

It is the policy of the College to award financial assistance--within the limits of available money—to eligible students.

Title FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS			

1. Federal Financial Aid

- 1.1 Students must submit an application online at <https://studentaid.gov/>.
- 1.2 Once approved for financial aid, students shall be required to adhere to College and federal financial aid guidelines.

2. Scholarships

- 2.1 Scholarship awards shall be based primarily on financial need and/or academic performance. However, specialized scholarship opportunities may have different standards. Scholarships shall be awarded without regard to age, sex, race, color, religion, or national origin (unless specified by the scholarship donor).
- 2.2 The Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships shall coordinate all scholarship award announcements and determine initial eligibility.
 - 2.2.1 Students shall complete scholarship applications that are available in the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships or on the College website.
 - 2.2.2 Students must meet the requirements of the specific scholarship, as outlined on the scholarship application.
- 2.3 Once approved for a scholarship, students shall be required to adhere to the guidelines as outlined by the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships.
