- Change to tuition or fees as approved by State Legislature

Amount of Cost Covered by VA Benefits

Chapter 33 recipients may be entitled to a percentage of the following VA Education Benefits based on the length of Service.

- Cost of tuition and fees for an in-state student (paid to the school and prorated based on eligibility percentage)
- Monthly housing allowance
Equal to the basic allowance for housing payable to a military E-5 with dependents,

in the same zip code as your school (paid to the student and prorated based on training time and the eligibility percentage)

- Yearly book and supply stipend
Up to \$1000 per year (paid to the student at \$84 per month of enrollment period per unit and prorated based on eligibility percentage).
